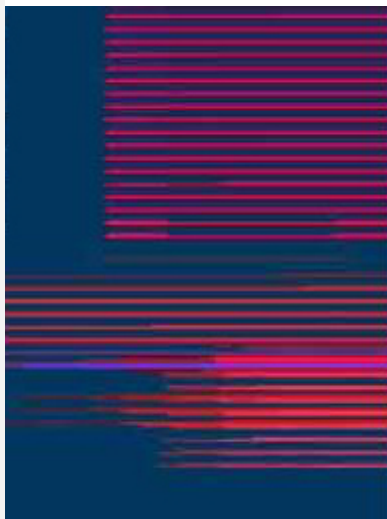

## Cowra Cemetery Database

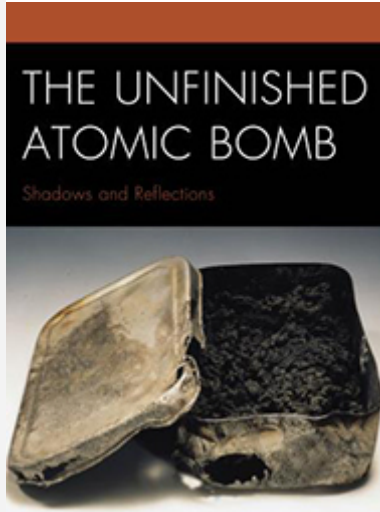
